#### 1 - Make a list

# 2 - Make a pile



With everyone in your house, write down the elements that make up your life. This is what you have to work with.

- What takes up your time?
- What are your routines and rituals?
- What are the spaces where you do life?
- What do you own that demands time, energy, and upkeep?
- What is on your schedule?
- What priorities usually do come first?

## 3 - Make a space



Look at the **core values** you want to live for, then evaluate each of the items on the pile. Ask:

- Is this item moving us *closer to* or *farther from* our values?
- If father from, is this an item we can reduce or remove?
- If it cannot be removed, can we find a healthier way to do it that includes a focus on our goals?
- What time and location could we set aside or utilize to help us move toward our values in Christ?
- Is there a new activity we need to include in our life?

### 4 - Make it happen



Make a **formal plan** that contains the times, locations, and actions you will take. Don't over do it. Pick one good thing to implement. If appropriate, sign it as a household and place it in a visible location.
